### **Drop-off Information**

Registration is at The Great Hall in Central Building One. An adult from each vehicle should come into the Great Hall with a list of all campers in their vehicle, no campers need to enter the Great Hall.

### **Pick-Up Information**

Campers and Counselors will be picked up at their grade level camp at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, July 1st. You must sign out with a camp director before leaving Lakeview.

### **Medical Information**

All medication (prescription and over-the-counter) must be given to the camp director on the first day of camp. Place the medication in its original container in a zip-lock bag with the camper's name and a Medication Information Form. Bring your medication to registration.

## **Counselors**

Each church is required to send one counselor for each 4 campers. The church is asked to cover the cost of their counselors (185.00). It is the responsibility of the local church to complete Safe Sanctuary certification for each adult prior to camp. Information for the State Safe Camps testing will be sent to each adult after we receive a completed registration form.

## **Adult Registration Form**

Complete the Counselor Registration Form and return it to your church for the pastor's signature. Be sure the entire registration form is filled out!

Please make sure that signatures, notary info, social security number, medical information, and T-shirt size are provided.

Incomplete registrations will be returned to the church and must be resubmitted.

### **Counselor's Cost \$ 185.00**

Counselors are required to be Safe Sanctuary certified prior to coming to camp.

ALL ADULTS MUST have the background check & pass the State Test online PRIOR to camp.

## **IMPORTANT !!!**

Counselors need to be at Lakeview by 5:30PM Sunday night—we will NOT be serving dinner so be sure to eat before you come.

## **Scholarships**

There are a limited number of partial scholarships available for both campers and counselors.

A request for scholarship must accompany the registration form, with an explanation of need and what the church has done to help raise local scholarships.

Please remember that our restores are limited this year.

## **Calling Home**

Campers are not allowed to call home during camp. For some being away from home can be a trying time. The leadership and counselors are committed to insuring your child has a positive experience at camp. Be assured that if there is a need for your child to call home he or she will be allowed to use the camp phone. We do ask that they do not turn on cell phones while at camp and that they do not allow other campers the use of their cell phones during camp.
