The Rev. Edward A. Kail, received his Master of Divinity degree from Princeton Theological Seminary. As District Superintendent, Chair for Town and Country Ministries at Saint Paul seminary, national president of the United Methodist Rural Fellowship, and as District Field Outreach Minister he has worked to strengthen rural churches and to develop and enhance the ministry of the laity.

Workshop Description: Many United Methodist Churches are in need of revitalization in the mission of Jesus Christ. Small membership churches face some particular challenges within the rapidly-changing social and cultural environments around them. In this workshop, we will consider approaches for pursuing missional revitalization through a scheme of discernment, research, action and continual learning. The aim: you will go home stirred up to work for Christ's kingdom! *The case for revitalization; The crucial move: Inside/Outside; Where's Jesus?; Which church are we?; What has happened to us?; Where are we?; Tools for community exploration; Small Membership Churches in action; What's working?; What is yet needed?*

The Rev. Dr. Kwasi Kena, serves as the Director of Evangelism Ministries for the United Methodist Church. Prior to his present position, Kwasi has served in a variety of ministry settings: cross-cultural, small church; new-church start; missionary to Ghana West Africa, Missionary in Residence at GBGM, Congregational Development Coordinator in the Greater New Jersey Annual Conference, Field Services Director and General Editor of UM Magazine for the General Commission on United Methodist Men. Kwasi is a teacher, preacher, writer, and musician. His great passion is helping people discover a spiritual "a ha."

Keynote Address Title and Description: When You Say 'Church' What Do You Mean? Church, over the millennia the architecture has changed, but what about its purpose? What do people want, need, and expect from "the church" today? The denominational decline indicates that many people are yawning at what many churches offer. This day-long seminar will provide participants with a variety of practical ways to create a dynamic church culture that inspires people to want to be Christ-followers. Topics covered include: preaching to engage, real-world evangelism, talking about the Jesus we say we love.
